1835 - CUTLER PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH - 1985

The Cutler and Geetingsville Presbyterian Church both came from the same origin.

This began August 1, 1835 when a group of nine under Crawfordsville Presbytery and the guidance of the Frankfort Church's minister organized in a log barn in the Geetingsville vicinity. A newly built log school house soon became their meeting place.

Their first church building was built at Lexington in 1844 with a membership of 25, because of its central location since some members lived North of the Wildcat Creek.

In about 10 years the membership had grown to 69 and for convenience they divided into two worship groups but kept the one organization and one minister. The southern group built a church just north of Geetingsville called "Hyde Park" and the northern group built a church and manse east of Cutler and called it the "North Fork".

The present Cutler church was built in 1890 and the manse in 1894. The addition on the south was added in 1914 and the restrooms in 1961.

We welcome Rev. Edward Morris and Rev. William Beswick to our pulpit today and in helping with our 150th year celebration.

We welcome all our former ministers and guests and invite you to spend the day with us.
