



In December 1904, the Delphi Library board was informed that if the city would find a site and contribute \$1,000 annually, Andrew Carnegie would contribute the sum of \$10,000 for a public library. The new library was dedicated in 1905.

This photo shows the library in the final stage of completion. The site chosen was the southwest corner of Main and Union streets. In the background can be seen the standpipe of the Delphi Water Works.
